# End of Year Concert

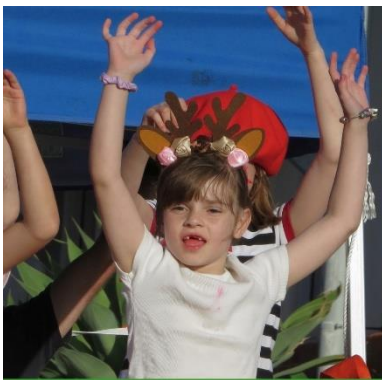
